The Strathfield Orchestral Society received a Cultural
Grant of \$150.00 from the Cultural Grants Advisory
Council of New South Wales.

MARK MCGHEE, a third year student in Bachelor of Music at Sydney University, will be the Soloist in Beethoven's Third Piano Concerto.

Mark, a pupil of Mary Greville of Lane Cove, holds the L.Mus.A. (Licentiate of Music in Australia) and the F.T.C.L. (Fellow of Trinity College of London). He has also had lessons with Claudio Arrau's assistant, Greville Rothen.

In the last few years, Mark has participated in Music Rostrum, won the City of Sydney Bach Championship in 1977, was a State finalist in the ABC Concerto Competitions in 1978 and won the Open Section of the N.S.W. Musical Association's Exhibitions in 1978. He has given recitals for the Pro Musica Society and in Young Australia broadcasts for the ABC. After completing his degree, he hopes to gain further experience overseas.

This will be the first time that the new Kawai grand piano, purchased jointly by the Strathfield Rotary Club, Strathfield Municipal Council and the Orchestra's Society, has been used for a Concerto performance.
