

### PROGRAMME NOTES

Carl Weber 1786-1826

Hungarian Rondo

Carl Maria von Weber was born into a strange German family but with many musical associations. His father was delighted when his son developed as a child prodigy (he composed his first opera at 12 years of age).

Carl composed an enormous quantity of music in his short 39 years of life. Beethoven was his inspiration, but he developed a very romantic stop of his own from the classical model.

This Rondo is a small early work.

Franz Joseph Haydn 1732-1809 Concerto for Oboe

Haydn was also a child prodigy living in Germany and Austria. He developed the classical form of music of his day so that now he must be considered the father of the symphonic form of music.

The Concerto we play tonight is a good example of his instrumental compositions.

\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart 1756-1791 Piano Concerto

Mozart was also a child prodigy in Austria. His music was originally based on the Haydn tradition, but he developed and expanded his style so that this last of his piano concertos is in many ways his most beautiful.

Anton Stepanovitch Arensky 1861-1906 Piano Fantasia

Arensky was a Russian child prodigy, having written his first string quartet when only 9 years old. He became a very distinguished composer, and, as was the fashion of his time, used folk music themes for much of his work. This Fantasia is one such, and it demonstrates his great romantic ability to use the instruments of an orchestra.

Our Viola Soloist is Louisa Brand. She is Sydney's most promising young viola players. She leads the viola section in The SBS Youth Orchestra.

Leisa Radford is currently completing her final year of a Bachelor of Music degree at Sydney Conservatorium of Music, studying with Josef Hanic and Linda Walsh.

Leisa has been Principal Oboe with The SBS Youth Orchestra, from 1989 to the present, and a regular member of the Sydney Conservatorium Symphony Orchestra. She is a regular player in Sydney and Newcastle, doing symphonic work with orchestras such as the Sydney Youth Orchestra, the Cove Chamber Orchestra, and operatic and musical productions.

Phillip Shovk began studying the piano at the age of 9 and continued his studies at the Conservatorium High School with George Humphrey. After graduating with the Frank Hutchens Memorial Prize for being the most promising performer, Philip left for the Moscow State Conservatory.

He graduated in 1984 with both his Diploma and a special Master of Fine Arts Award.

Phillip is a Laureate of International Competitions which include Lisbon 1987 (5th prize) and Sydn 1988 (6th prize) and the Best Australian Pianist Award.

In 1990 he was awarded a Diploma of Honour at the Tchaikovsky Competition in Moscow and is currently on the staff of the Sydney Conservatorium of Music.




