



### PROGRAMME NOTES

Tonight's Concert is all from the Classical Period, when music was gentle, refined and beautiful.

Symphony No.104 (London)

Joseph Haydn (1732-1809)

Haydn is notorious for the vast quantity of music he composed, largely in Vienna. He developed the form of the Symphony to the style still largely recognised. His last Symphony, no.104, was written in 1795 in London, and is generally accepted as his greatest. Certainly it is his most popular.

We play the last two movements only.

Concerto for Two Flutes

Domenico Cimarosa (1749-1801)

At the same time in Italy, Domenico Cimarosa was composing in many ways in a similar style to Mozart and Haydn. He travelled to Vienna, and we wonder, could these three have met?

This double flute Concerto is a fine example of the style of those days.

We are happy to welcome our Soloists:

Belinda Gough and Yvonne Frindle Franz Schubert (1797-1828)

We continue with music from the Vienna of a few years later.

Franz Schubert wrote nine symphonies. Strangely, the sixth in C, is seldom played, but the orchestra has come to like this symphony very much. It should not be neglected for it has so much ingenious beauty and must be considered as a fine work. Like all Schubert symphonies, it is written for a small intimate style orchestra, for which we have the affrontery to consider ourselves most suitable.

Belinda gained a Bachelor of Music degree and is now at the Conservatorium of Music completing her Master of Music Degree.


She has gained many awards and played in Europe, America and Japan.
